Personal data that may be processed:

Fysicon B.V. may process your personal data because you use the services of Fysicon B.V. and/or because you provide this data yourself to Fysicon B.V. when completing a form on the website. Fysicon B.V. may process the following personal data:

- Your first and last name - Your job title - Your gender
- Your department
- Your address details
- Your telephone number
- Your email address
- Your IP address
- Your company name and its address details
- Information about your location, device, browser settings, and browsing behaviour

Why Fysicon B.V. needs data:

1. To perform the contract that has been concluded

Fysicon B.V. may use your personal data in the context of performing an agreement of assignment entered into with you. For example, for sending a newsletter.

2. Contact after a contact request

Fysicon B.V. processes your personal data in order to contact you by telephone if you request this and/or to contact you in writing (by email and/or by post) if you cannot be reached by telephone.

3. Newsletter

To send a personalized newsletter, we require your email address and full name. These details are used solely for sending the newsletter. You can unsubscribe from our newsletter at any time via the link at the bottom of each newsletter.

4. Optimizing, improving, and securing the operation of the website

On the website of Fysicon B.V., general visitor data is recorded, including the IP address of your computer, the time of the request, and data sent by your browser. This data is used for analyses of visitor and click behavior on the website, for securing our website, and for the correct functioning of our website and related plugins or web applications. Fysicon B.V. uses this information to optimize, improve, and secure the operation of the website as much as possible. Fysicon B.V. may share this data with third parties or third-party applications such as Google Analytics. See the section "Sharing with third parties."

5. **Functional cookies**

We use functional cookies that are necessary for the proper functioning of our site. Cookies are files stored on your computer, for example to distinguish users or to store items in a shopping cart. These cookies can be removed at any time via the browser settings of your computer.

6. **Tracking cookies**

In addition to functional cookies, we may use tracking cookies. These analyze browsing behavior and examine advertising preferences. For this purpose, we use external software such as a Facebook pixel. Before using these tracking cookies, we explicitly request permission during your visit to our website. This request is shown in the so-called cookie notice bar at the top of the page. You are not required to accept these cookies in order to visit our website. Furthermore, these cookies can be removed at any time via the browser settings of the computer. After this, permission will be requested again.

7. **Use of social media integrations**

Our pages may contain plugins from social networks such as Facebook, LinkedIn, and Twitter. When these are used and you are logged in to one of these services, these networks may receive data about your browsing behavior. When you visit our pages, a direct connection may be established via these social media plugins between your browser and the servers of the social media networks. This allows these parties to know that you have visited our website with your IP address. In this way, for example, Facebook can link your visit to our pages to your user account. We would like to point out that we, as the provider of the pages, are not informed about the content of the transmitted data or its use by these companies. If you do not want these companies to associate your visit to our pages with your social media account, you must log out of the social media channels before visiting our website.

8. **Use of other plugin scripts and web fonts**

Our website uses JavaScript code to ensure proper operation and display of our website. This code may also originate from an external party such as Google Web Fonts. If you have JavaScript enabled in your browser and have not installed a JavaScript blocker, your browser may transmit personal data when code is loaded by one of our suppliers. We do not know which data is linked to the received data and for what purposes this data is used. You can prevent JavaScript code from being executed by installing a JavaScript blocker (for example, www.noscript.net).

How long Fysicon B.V. stores data

Fysicon B.V. does not store your personal data longer than strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which your data is collected. Your data will not be stored for longer than 26 months if no agreement is concluded with you, or after such an agreement is terminated. Cookies can be removed by you at any time via the browser settings.

Sharing with third parties

Fysicon B.V. provides your personal data to third parties only if this is necessary for the execution of an agreement with you, to comply with a legal obligation, or to optimize, improve, and secure the operation of our website. This also includes sharing information with web applications, suppliers, and hosting providers that are necessary for the operation of our site and web functionalities. We will handle this data carefully by transmitting it as anonymously as possible and by concluding a data processing agreement with third parties that offer such an agreement. Personal data may also be shared with third parties when we use tracking cookies. These will be used solely for our own marketing purposes and will not be shared with or sold to third parties. Above you will find more information on how we use these cookies and how you can give consent.

Accessing, modifying, or deleting data

You have the right to access, correct, or delete your personal data. You can submit a request for access, correction, or deletion by post or by email using the contact information at the bottom of this page. Fysicon B.V. will respond to your request as soon as possible, but within four weeks.

Fysicon B.V. takes the protection of your data seriously and takes appropriate measures to prevent misuse, loss, unauthorized access, unwanted disclosure, and unauthorized modification. The website of Fysicon B.V. uses a reliable SSL certificate to safeguard your personal data.
